

REGULATION RESPECTING PERIODS OF REFRESHER TRAINING AND REFRESHER COURSES THAT MAY BE IMPOSED ON PHYSICIANS

Medical Act

(R.S.Q., c. M-9, s. 3)

Professional Code

(R.S.Q., c. C-26, s. 94, par. j)

1. The number of years allowing application of the first paragraph of section 45.3 of the Professional Code (R.S.Q., c. C-26) is 3 years.

The number of years allowing application of the second paragraph of section 45.3 of the Code is 2 years when the holder of a permit had been struck from the roll and 3 years in other cases.

2. Allowing application of section 55 of the Professional Code are the following cases:

(1) a physician who has resumed his right to practice medicine 2 years or more after this right had been limited or suspended;

(2) a physician who has ceased to practice medicine with patients for a period of 3 years or more, unless he had practiced medicine for a period equivalent to more than 12 months during the last 5 years;

(3) a physician who has begun to practice medicine in a field in which he had never previously practiced or after practicing in another field for 3 years or more; this change must be reported by the physician to the secretary of the Collège des médecins du Québec;

(4) a physician who has practiced medicine for a period equivalent to less than 12 months during the last 5 years;

(5) a physician who has failed a voluntary period of training supervised by a physician in order to refresh his professional practice or update his competencies.

3. This regulation replaces the Regulation respecting refresher training and courses that may be imposed on physicians (c. M-9, r. 27).
